

## S4.2: Mix-and-match on the definition of "defaulter"

In this exercise the sentences in the first and in the second column are given separately to the participants, who must match the sentences in the second column to the sentences in the first column. The exercise can be given individually or in pairs.

### Assignment for the participants:

First sentence must be matched by the	second sentence
Patients with PB leprosy	cannot complete treatment in the maximum time allowed, which is nine months, and should be declared as defaulters from treatment; this should be indicated in the Leprosy Treatment Register under "Treatment Outcome"
Patients with MB leprosy	fail to complete treatment within the maximally allowed time frame
In general, defaulters are persons who	can complete treatment in the maximum time allowed, and should not be declared as defaulters from treatment but continue treatment.
Whenever PB patients have missed more than 3 months treatment, they	can complete treatment in the maximum time allowed, and should not be declared as defaulters from treatment but continue treatment.
Whenever MB patients have missed more than 6 months treatment, they	have to complete 12 months treatment within a <b>maximum</b> of 18 months
Whenever PB patients have missed less than 3 months treatment, they	cannot complete treatment in the maximum time allowed, which is 18 months, and should be declared as defaulters from treatment; this should be indicated in the Leprosy Treatment Register under "Treatment Outcome"
Whenever MB patients have missed less than 6 months treatment, they	have to complete 6 months treatment within a <b>maximum</b> period of 9 months
